In eight separate instances, students were assigned **one (1)** judicial point for an alcohol violation in the Village of Clinton.

In 22 separate instances, students were assigned **two (2)** judicial points for an alcohol violation and minor in possession of alcohol in the Village of Clinton.

A student who was in violation of the posted quiet hours received **one (1)** judicial point.

In five separate instances, students whose behavior was disruptive received **2 (two)** judicial points.

In 10 separate instances, students possessing an open container of alcohol and being under the age of 21 received **two (2)** judicial points.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for violating the smoking policy.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for lewd/indecent behavior.

Two students were each assigned **two (2)** judicial points for switching residence hall rooms without permission.

Six students (seniors) were each assigned **three (3)** judicial points for illegal room changes and attempting to manipulate the housing lottery.

Three students who attempted to manipulate the housing lottery by participating in an illegal room change will have 150 points added to their housing lottery number and will not be allowed to pull or be pulled into a room during the April '08 housing lottery.

In two separate instances, students in possession of drug paraphernalia (marijuana pipe) received **three (3)** judicial points.

In four separate instances, students either possessing or using marijuana received **four (4)** judicial points.

Two students who moved furniture from Beinecke Village into their on-campus apartment without authorization received **four (4)** judicial points.

A student who accessed another student's e-mail account without authorization received **five (5)** judicial points.

In four separate instances, students who admitted responsibility for damage or vandalism received **six (6)** judicial points and were billed double for the cost of repairs.

A student who discharged a fire extinguisher in a residence hall was assigned **six (6)** judicial points.

A student who forged his advisor's signature on an add/drop form was assigned **six (6)** judicial points.

A student who was found responsible for a second violation of the smoking policy and covering a smoke detector was **suspended for one semester**.

A student who was arrested in the Village of Clinton for driving while intoxicated was **suspended for two semesters**.

A student who was arrested for a second offense of driving while intoxicated was **expelled from the college**.
