

## Fall 2008

In four separate instances, students were assigned **one (1)** judicial point for possessing an open container of alcohol.

In 33 separate instances, students were assigned **two (2)** judicial points for open container violations and possession of alcohol as a minor.

In five separate instances, students whose behavior was disruptive in the Village of Clinton received **two (2)** judicial points.

In eight separate instances, students in possession of drug paraphernalia received **two (2)** judicial points.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for a violation of the pet policy.

A student received **two (2)** judicial points for unauthorized entry into a locked facility.

In three separate instances, students received **two (2)** judicial points of possession of a candle.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for violation of the alcohol policy and failure to comply with the request of a college official.

Three students received **three (3)** judicial points for possession of marijuana.

Ten students received **three (3)** judicial points for disruptive behavior in a residence hall.

A student received **four (4)** judicial points for violation of the bulk alcohol policy.

Two students received **four (4)** judicial points for possession of a false ID.

Three students received **four (4)** judicial points for disruptive behavior a residence hall.

23 students received **four (4)** judicial points for possession and use of marijuana.

35 students received **four (4)** judicial points for violation of fire safety policies documented during residence hall fire safety inspections.

Two students received **five (5)** judicial points for possession and use of a fake ID

A student who admitted responsibility for vandalism received **six (6)** judicial points and was billed double for the cost of repairs.

A student received **six (6)** judicial points for possession and use of marijuana and a collection of marijuana paraphernalia.

A student received **six (six)** judicial points after being arrested for disorderly conduct in the Village of Clinton.

A student received **seven (7)** judicial points for violation of the alcohol policy and possession and use of marijuana.

A student who had 9 judicial points from previous violations was **suspended** for possession and use of marijuana.
