In 12 separate instances, students were assigned **one (1)** judicial point for excessive noise in a residence hall.

A student was assigned **one (1)** judicial point for possession of an unlit candle.

In six separate instances, students were assigned **two (2)** judicial points for open container violations and possession of alcohol as a minor.

12 students were assigned **two (2)** judicial points for disruptive behavior in a residence hall.

A student was assigned **two (2)** judicial points for possession of drug paraphernalia.

Two students each received **two (2)** judicial points for burning a candle in their residence hall room.

In two separate instances, a student received **three (3)** judicial points for violation of the alcohol policy and failure to comply with the request of a college official.

A student received **three (3)** judicial points for disorderly conduct in the Village of Clinton.

12 students received **four (4)** judicial points for possession and use of marijuana.

A student received **four (4)** judicial points for multiple violations of the pet policy.

A student received **five (5)** judicial points for violation of the bulk alcohol policy.

In three separate instances, students who admitted responsibility for vandalism received **6 (six)** judicial points and were billed double for the cost of repairs.

A student received **six (6)** judicial points after being arrested for lewd and disorderly conduct in the Village of Clinton.

A student who admitted responsibility for vandalism and was in possession of drug paraphernalia received **eight (8)** judicial points.

A student was assigned **nine (9)** judicial points for possession of marijuana, drug paraphernalia and a pellet gun.

A student was **suspended for two semesters** for lewd and disorderly conduct and abusive behavior toward a police officer in the Village of Clinton.

Two students found responsible for distributing drugs were **expelled** from the College.
