SMOKE FREE HOUSING CONTRACT**

In choosing to reside in Smoke Free Housing, students will live in an environment which does not permit smoking in the residence hall. Since state law and college policy prohibit smoking in public and common areas of every building on campus, Smoke Free Housing essentially extends that environment to include individual student rooms.

Each person in this community agrees to confront other students if the smoke free living environment is not being supported at any time. If any student is found to disrupt this environment by smoking anywhere in the residence hall, the individual may be required to move from Smoke Free Housing to another residence hall or house on campus.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. I agree not to smoke anywhere inside or around my residence hall which includes a ten foot perimeter around the entire building.
2. I agree to confront anyone found smoking inside or around my residence hall and will report those individuals to my Resident Advisor immediately.
3. I agree to hold all of my guests accountable to these guidelines.
4. I agree to support all programs that benefit the smoke free community.

I understand and agree to abide by all of the conditions of this contract.
