DVDs and Region Codes





As reported earlier, the DVDs are now available on the second floor of Burke Library. DVDs may be checked out for three days, with reserve DVDs having a 3 hours loan period, unless otherwise designated. Please be aware the DVDs have different codes, depending on where they are manufactured. DVDs purchased in the United States are Region 1, while DVDs from other countries have different regions. DVD players are designed to only play the DVDs in the country where the player was purchased, unless they are designated as "region free." Please note that non-region 1 DVDs cannot be played on your personal computer! You can damage your personal computer by playing non-region 1 DVDs. Non-region 1 DVDs must be played on the library viewing stations located on the rear of the first floor, or the basement of Burke Library. All non-region 1 DVDs are labeled as such.
