## Fall 2012 Summary of Code of Student Conduct Violations and Sanctions

## One Judicial Point:

- Two students of legal drinking age received one point each for possession of an open container of alcohol in a public area


## Two Judicial Points:

- Five students received two points each for disruptive behavior / excessive noise
- Three students received two points each for possession of a false ID
- 36 students under the age of 21 received two points each for possession/consumption of alcohol


## Three Judicial Points:

- Four students received three points each for possession of drug paraphernalia


## Four Judicial Points:

- One student received four points for theft of property
- 16 students received four points each for possession or use of marijuana ( $1^{\text {st }}$ violation)
- One student received four points for unauthorized entry to the mail center
- Two students received four points each for an alcohol policy violation and failure to comply with Campus Safety


## Five Judicial Points:

- Two students received five points each for theft of property and disruptive behavior
- Three students received five points each for theft and possession of multiple pieces of Hamilton furniture
- Six students received five points each for disruptive behavior, violating the alcohol policy and failure to comply with Campus Safety
- Three students received five points each for possession or use of marijuana ( $2^{\text {nd }}$ violation)


## Six Judicial Points

- One student received six judicial points for damaging property and providing alcohol to minors


## Seven Judicial Points:

- A student received seven points for disruptive behavior and failing to comply with Campus Safety on multiple occasions
- A student received seven points for violating the alcohol policy and recklessly activating the building fire alarm
- A student received seven points for violating the alcohol policy, damaging property and providing false information to Campus Safety


## Eight Judicial Points:

- Four students received eight points each for endangering the health and safety of other students and providing alcohol to minors.
- One student received eight points for violating the alcohol policy, damaging property and providing false information to Campus Safety


## Nine Judicial Points:

- Two students received nine points each for violating the alcohol policy, damaging property and providing false information to Campus Safety


## Ten Judicial Points:

- A student with previous violations accrued ten points and was suspended for one semester for providing alcohol to minors
- A student received ten points and was suspended for one semester for violating the alcohol policy, damaging property and providing false information to Campus Safety
- Two students received ten points each for engaging in actions that endangered the health and safety of others by driving while intoxicated on or near campus.
- A student received 10 points and was expelled for a second incident of assaulting another student.
