The Music Department is delighted to hear that you will be coming to Hamilton in the fall, and I invite you to visit us in the Schambach Center. You will find that Hamilton offers a wide variety of opportunities for making music through our department's program in private study and in student ensembles. These groups are listed and described on the Music page of the Advising Viewbook.

If you sing or play an instrument, we encourage you to meet the conductors of our performing groups during Orientation Week. Most groups are open by audition, which will be held during that week. It would be wise, of course, to keep practicing during the summer!

Hamilton offers private instruction in voice, piano, organ, the standard orchestral instruments, classical guitar and jazz instruments. By special arrangement, most instruction in orchestral instruments is offered by members of the Syracuse Symphony, who come to campus once a week for eleven weeks each term. Instruction is moderately priced at \$484 per term (eleven one-hour lessons); half-hour lessons at \$242 per term are also available. Financial aid may be available to help offset this extra cost. Times and places for instruction will be determined next fall and will be based on the schedules of both teacher and student. Please stop by the Music Department Office in List 111 during the first week of classes to sign up for private lessons with Anne Riffle, Administrative Office Assistant for the Music and Theatre & Dance Departments.
