Mobile Library Resources

[Research Aids: Mobile Library](#) gives you access to many library resources on your mobile device. Databases and library catalogs such as ALEX, WorldCat, EBSCO's Academic Search Premier and RefWorks are some of the myriad of resources now available.

Please note that many mobile library sites are in their first release, so our technical support may be limited. Check it out and let us know what you think.



Use [RefWorks](#) to create, organize, and store references. References can be imported from ALEX (the library catalog) and most other databases, or entered manually one-by-one. The references can then be formatted for bibliographies in many style formats (e.g., APA, MLA, Chicago Manual of Style, etc.).
