2016-2017 Mentee Participation Agreement

Mentee participants with the Multicultural Peer Mentoring Project are expected to adhere to the following requirements:

- I should use appropriate language in all correspondence and interact with my Peer Mentor in a courteous and respectful manner;
- I must maintain confidentiality with any personal information my Peer Mentor shares with me;
- I will notify the Associate Dean of Students for Multicultural Affairs and Accessibility Services and/or the program's Student Intern(s) of any Peer Mentor who acts inappropriately during in-person interactions and/or other communication; and
- I should respond in a timely manner to all requests related to the peer mentoring experience made by the Associate Dean of Students for Multicultural Affairs and Accessibility Services and/or the program's Student Intern(s).

I have read and understand the above statements. I understand that full participation in the peer mentoring experience and meeting the above mentioned guidelines are requirements for being a participant in the *Multicultural Peer Mentoring Project* and I agree to fulfill these responsibilities to the best of my ability.
