

Concentration GPA Worksheet

How to Calculate the GPA in a concentration

1. Enter Course Numbers, Grades and Units for each course that counts toward the concentration. Do not include courses graded as CR (credit) or S (Satisfactory). These grades have no numeric value and should not be included in the GPA calculation.
2. Enter Numeric Equivalents for the grades (See the chart below).
3. Multiply Numeric Equivalents by number of Units for each course, and enter results in Points column.
4. Total the Units column and the Points column. Divide the total points by the total units to determine the Grade Point Average.

Numeric Equivalents:

A+ = 4.3 A = 4.0 A- = 3.7 B+ = 3.3 B = 3.0 B- = 2.7
 C+ = 2.3 C = 2.0 C- = 1.7 D+ = 1.3 D = 1.0 D- = 0.7
 F = 0 FF = -1.5 XF = -1.5
