2023-24 STUDENT ACCOUNT INFORMATION

Term Billing Dates:

Fall 2023 tuition bills will be available online by 7/15/23 with payment due on 8/15/23.

Spring 2024 tuition bills will be available online by 12/10/23 with payment due on 1/10/24.

Late Payment Policy:

If payment is not received by the due date, a late fee of 1% per month will be assessed.

Students with unpaid balances will not be able to:

- Pre-register for the next term
- Participate in the housing lottery
- Apply to study abroad programs

Electronic Tuition Statements

Tuition bills will only be available online through the Cashnet portal: <https://www.hamilton.edu/offices/business/student-accounts/cashnet>

Parents or guardians can gain access to the Cashnet account by having your student grant you access under the My Account tab in Cashnet. This will allow you to review all account activity and receive monthly notifications from our office.

You can view the real time billing under the Activity Details tab of the Cashnet account. You can view all charges and credits to the account along with the current balance due.

Statements can be found under the Statements tab on the Cashnet account. An email will be sent each month to both the student and the authorized payer when an updated statement is ready to view.

Installment Payment Plan: Enrollment is per semester and should be initiated in July and December as the first payments are due. An administrative fee of \$35 is charged for enrolling in the semester plan (fee is charged each semester). Payment is made through the Cashnet account.

International Payments: We offer wire payments through Flywire or PayMyTuition for all international payments.

529 Funds: Several 529 providers are available electronically in Cashnet. If your provider is not listed, your 529 provider should be contacted and a payment initiated directly to Hamilton College. Payments can take up to two weeks to arrive.

Student Health Insurance:

Hamilton requires that all students have health insurance coverage. Students who enroll at Hamilton will be billed for the Hamilton College Student Health Insurance Plan unless they submit an online waiver and provide proof of alternate coverage.

This waiver must be completed annually prior to the start of the Fall Semester.

Tuition Insurance:

Hamilton offers a tuition refund plan through A.W.G. Dewar, Inc.

This plan is designed to protect you from the loss of tuition, room and board should you find it necessary to withdraw from the College because of illness, accident, or other medical reasons.

In order to reduce the cost of the annual premium, **students are automatically enrolled in the plan and billed half of the annual premium at the start of each semester. Students may opt out of the insurance by completing an online waiver at:**

The premium for 2023-24 is \$510 per year, billed at \$255 per semester.
