27 ROOT GLEN

Nature lovers may want to carve out time for a stroll along the red shale paths of Hamilton's Root Glen, a seven-and-a-half acre wooded garden and ravine with a small stream. It's a perfect place to unwind and enjoy the many species of trees, shrubs, and flowers. The glen was originally owned by the family of Elihu Root, a Hamilton graduate who won the 1912 Nobel Peace Prize. Hamilton's campus is a designated arboretum where trees are grown for scientific and educational purposes. Adjacent to the Root Glen is a larger glen that students use for hiking, jogging, cross country skiing, and snowshoeing.
