Library computers automatically log you out after 20 minutes of inactivity to protect your privacy. If you open a document from my.hamilton in a browser window, it is especially important to save it to your network share. Help us help you by saving your work. 
Avoid a Late Notice! All Books are Due Saturday, December 17, 2011.
