


### Give a Fond Farewell!

## Olivia Susan Clemens Correspondence Available Digitally



The college archive is privileged to house a collection of letters written by Susan "Susy" Olivia Clemens (1872-1896), daughter of Samuel Clemens ("Mark Twain") to her college friend Louise Brownell (1870-1961). Louise was later married to Arthur Percy Saunders (1869-1953), professor of chemistry and dean of Hamilton College. This image is one of the many letters digitized and available from the library's web site.

This collection includes images of 44 letters (396 pages) written by Susy Clemens between 1891 and 1894 from Bryn Mawr, Hartford, Connecticut and from Switzerland, Germany, Italy, and France as she traveled with her father.
