More Places for Individual Study in Burke

Students have told us that we should create more spaces for individual quiet study in the Burke Library. During the final exam period we will be doing an experiment with the classrooms on the second floor of the Burke Library.

Starting after the last day of classes and through finals week, the tables and chairs in the Burke Library second floor classrooms will be rearranged so they go around the outside of the room – rather than in the center, with the chairs facing either the windows or the walls. In this way each room will be usable by roughly twenty students for individual study.

We have created five study carrels in the basement (to the left when you come down the stairs). This is a first step in creating spaces to view media as we move the Media Library to Burke over the summer.

Don't Lose Your Work!

It happens every semester. A student is working on his thesis, saves the file to the desktop, and leaves for a quick break outside. While he's gone, the library PC logs off. When the student logs back in, he discovers the thesis is no longer on the desktop.

Please remember to log in to your **HAMILTON-S** account and save all work to your network share or to an external device. Do not save your work to the desktop! Library computers automatically log you out after 20 minutes of inactivity to protect your privacy. If you open a document from my.hamilton in a browser window, it is especially important to save it to your network share.

Media Library to Move to Burke This Summer

Over the summer the Media Library will move to the Burke Library and the existing space in Christian Johnson will be renovated for the new Quantitative and Symbolic Reasoning (QSR) Center. By moving the Media Library we will make it possible to browse the DVDs (to be located on the second floor) and make the entire collection available for additional hours each week.

All the technology in the Media Library will be replaced with new VHS/DVD players and LCD panels. Viewing stations will be located on the lower level and first floors of Burke. Additionally, one or more of the classrooms on the second floor will be equipped with surround sound and upgraded DVD/VHS players to support group viewing.
