

You are eligible for enrollment in the College's retirement plan. Please see plan and enrollment information as follows:

Retirement Plan

Under the College's 403(b) Retirement Plan, the College contributes the equivalent of 10% of your earnings to a retirement account with TIAA commencing after one year of service. Please follow the instructions below to enroll online. Even if you previously completed the enrollment for a voluntary contribution you still must complete the enrollment for the College contribution. The login that you set up to enroll will provide access to your account. As part of the enrollment you will specify how you want your funds invested and designate a beneficiary. You may change these elections at any time.

To enroll online for an account with TIAA:

- Click this link to go to the TIAA website (Please note, if you are not able to proceed through a step along the way, you may need to try the link in a different browser)
- In the blue box click "Ready to Enroll"
- Choose the plan " Hamilton College 403 (b) Retirement Plan (Employer Contribution)"
- Click "Next"
- On this page **ignore the section that says** "Decide how much you want to **contribute**" and scroll down and click the yellow button "Begin Enrollment"
- If you are a first-time user: Click register with TIAA to create your user ID and password
 - If you are a returning user: Enter your TIAA user ID and click Log in
- Follow the prompts to complete your enrollment. If not already populated, the access code is 150587ER.

If you do not provide or update your investment instructions, the Qualified Default Investment Alternative Initial Notice and Fact Sheet will apply.
