### *Who we are and what we do:*

Cram & Scram is a student-run, college-sponsored reuse/recycle group which aims to reduce the amount of waste left behind by students at the end of the school year. We collect reusable goods and food, re-selling some items and donating others to charity. Last year, we reduced Hamilton College's total waste by an estimated 50 tons (more than a third) and became fiscally self-sustaining.
