## **Enrollment Update**

- At the start of the spring semester, Hamilton welcomed 38 first-year students and 12 transfers
- Admission for the Class of 2021
  - O Applications total 5,678, a record; this represents an increase of 8.6% over last year and a 4.5% increase over the prior all-time high achieved in 2015
  - Notification for Regular Decision applicants is March 24

## News from On and Off Campus

- The College announced the Johnson-Pote Director's Fund at the Wellin Museum; it is named for Linda Johnson '80 and her late husband Harold Pote
- Recent Grant Activity:
  - o \$500,000 from the Emerson Foundation to supplement the Fred L. Emerson Scholarship; the award includes a three-year 10-to-one challenge
  - o \$103,739 to Cynthia Downs (biology) from the National Science Foundation (pending, but recommended for funding)
  - \$56,281 to Erica De Bruin (government) from the National Science Foundation (part of a larger grant with colleagues from SUNY Binghamton; pending, but recommended for funding)
  - \$12,490 to Tom Jones (anthropology) from the National Science Foundation (part of a larger grant with colleagues from Cal State Sacramento)
  - o \$3,500 from the Mid Atlantic Foundation to support the performing arts
- The four committees that will lead the Strategic Planning process were announced in January:
  - o Steering Committee, Interim Dean Margaret Gentry, Chair
  - o Academic Vision Committee, Professor Marianne Janack, Chair
  - o Student Success Committee, Professor Onno Oerlemans, Chair
  - o Imagining Hamilton Committee, Vice President Monica Inzer, Chair
- Five students have been awarded U.S. State Department-sponsored Gilman Scholarships to study abroad this spring; these are in addition to two recipients for fall 2016 and one for summer 2016
- Two students, one from Sudan and one from Iran, are affected by the Executive Order on Immigration; efforts to support international students include regular on-campus consultations with immigration attorney Helen McGee Konrad '84
